Travelling from the UK to France

The highest percentage of international visitors to France come from the UK. Many of the UK visitors to France own holiday homes there. Other UK tourists stay in gites (self-catering accommodation), camp sites or hotels.

Travel from the UK to France is easy. People can take their cars by ferry across the sea or by rail tunnel. There is also a high-speed rail link between London and Paris which uses the tunnel. Short-haul flights are also available from many UK airports.
